Moved by Director Sorenson, supported by Director Hollowell, to approve Res. 2019-297, Limited Waiver of Sovereign Immunity and Consent to Waiver of Tribal Court Jurisdiction for White Pine Lodge Enterprises Liquor License.

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Directors for the Sault Ste. Tribe of Chippewa Indians:

Section 1 FINDINGS AND DETERMINATIONS: The Board of Directors finds and determines that:

- 1.1 The tribe has purchased White Pine Lodge hotel and convenience store located in Christmas, MI, as a wholly owned governmental instrumentality of the tribe.
- 1.2 The purchase includes the transfer of a state liquor license from the seller to the tribe in the name of White Pine Lodge Enterprises
- 1.3 The state of Michigan is unable to transfer the liquor license to the tribe in the name of White Pine Lodge Enterprises absent a limited waiver of sovereign immunity from the tribe in favor of the state.
- In order to facilitate the transfer of the liquor license the tribe pledges herein to not claim tribal immunity or exclusive Tribal Court jurisdiction with respect to any disputes or causes of action between the state and tribe that might arise from, or relate to, in any respect, the state liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises as limited below. All of the foregoing are referred to herein as the "Waiver and Consent Obligations."
- 1.5 It is in the Tribe's interest to resolve as stated herein.

Section 2 WAIVER OF SOVEREIGN IMMUNITY; CONSENT TO JURISDICTION; GOVERNING LAW

- 2.1 The tribe hereby waives its sovereign immunity from suit in favor of the state of Michigan only should an action be commenced by the state in furtherance of its obligations to regulate the liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises. This waiver is not granted for any other state of Michigan liquor licenses the tribe may possess or for any issue arising under the tribe's gaming compact in its current form or as it may be amended or replaced.

 This waiver:
- i) shall terminate upon the tribe no longer having a state of Michigan liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises;
- ii) is granted solely to the state of Michigan in the state's furtherance of its obligations to regulate the state of Michigan liquor license at White Pine Lodge Enterprises;
- iii) shall extend to inter alia, any judicial or non judicial action, including, but not limited to, any lawsuit, arbitration, and judicial or non judicial action to resolve disputes between the Tribe and the state of Michigan, and the assertion of any claim in a court of competent jurisdiction or with any arbitrator or arbitration panel to enforce the obligations under the Agreement; iv) shall be limited to Tribal assets; and

v) shall be enforceable only in a court of competent jurisdiction, including courts of the State of Michigan, the Sault Chippewa Tribal Court and federal courts in Michigan (including the United States Bankruptcy Court) or any arbitrator or arbitration panel.

vi) shall not extend to any third party.

Section 4 WAIVER OF TRIBAL COURT JURISDICTION

The Board of Directors waives the exclusive jurisdiction of the Tribal Court over any action arising under section 2.

Lot 17 and the East ½ of Lot 18, Block 2, Lachance's Plat of a Portion of Private Claim Number 14, City of St. Ignace, Mackinac County, Michigan. Containing 0.206 acres more or less (8981 s.f.).

Subject to all easements, conditions, reservations, exceptions and restrictions contained in prior conveyances of record. RESOLVED, the lease is in furtherance of a housing program operated in the promotion of the public purposes and the negotiated rental amount has been determined to be in the best interest of the Tribe and its people, and valuation in accordance with 25 CFR 162.320 is hereby waived.

Motion carried unanimously.

Moved by Director McLeod, supported by Director Causley, to approve Res. 2019-299, Trust Land Lease – Parcel 34 Aikens Sault Ste. Marie, MI.

RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes its Tribal Chairman and Treasurer to execute a lease to the land located at Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan to: Randy W. Aikens and Brenda J. Aikens, husband and wife and land being described as follows:Parcel 34

A parcel of land located in the West ½ of the Northeast ¼ of Section 29, Town 47 North,

Range 1 East, Soo Township, Chippewa County, Michigan being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at the East ¼ corner of Section 29, Town 47 North, Range 1 East; thence North 01°39'16" East, along the East line of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 29, a distance of 660.75 feet to the Southeast corner of the North ½ of the Southeast ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 29; thence North 87°39'02" West, along the South line of the North ½ of the Southeast ¼ of the Northeast ¼ of said Section 29, a distance of 50.00 feet

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes Aaron Payment, Chairperson or designee, to sign, negotiate, amend, and execute any agreement thereof for the Bureau of Indian Affairs 2020 Self Governance Program and Tribal Transportation Program.

Roll Call Vote: Motion carried with Directors Hoffman, Sorenson, Matson, McKerchie, Gravelle, Massaway, McLeod, Morrow, Chase approving; Director Causley opposing; Director Hollowell abstaining.

Moved by Director Gravelle, supported by Director Hoffman, to approve Res. 2019-301, Chippewa County Community Foundation FY 2019 Sponsorships.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby approves the donation from CC#2083, Sponsorships, of \$1,500.00 to the Chippewa County Community Foundation to support three Sault Tribe Youth in attending a public service trip in Nicaragua.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby approves awarding the contract for well drilling as recommended by the Health Division and the Purchasing Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes Aaron A. Payment, Tribal Chairperson or his designee, to negotiate, execute and amend any contracts necessary on the Tribe's behalf with a budget of a \$67,100.00 for the drilling of these wells.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby approves awarding the contract for Business Plan Consultant as recommended by the Health Division and the Purchasing Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes Aaron A. Payment, Tribal Chairperson or his designee, to negotiate, execute and amend any contracts necessary on the Tribe's behalf with a budget of \$110,000 for the Recovery Hospital Business Plan and Feasibility Study.

Moved by Director McLeod, supported by Director Morrow, to approve Res. 2019-304, IHS Multi Year Funding Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Sault Tribe Board of Directors hereby approves the Funding Agreement as effective from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2021, and authorizes the Tribal Chairperson to execute such Agreement on behalf of the Tribe.

Motion carried unanimously.

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Moved Director Sorenson, supported by Director Massaway, to approve Res. 2019-305, Contract Approval Meritain Health (An AETNA Company) and Delta Dental.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Sault Ste. Marie Tribe of Chippewa Indians hereby authorizes the Tribal Chairperson, Aaron Payment, or his designee, to execute contracts with Meritain Health and Delta Dental, with an effective date of January 1, 2020, for a one year period, and to further take such actions as may be required to extend the current contracts.
